CENTRAL'S STATE OF AFFAIRS

Despite the many projects that have been completed over the last several years (new air-conditioning in the Sanctuary, windows in Fellowship Hall and the Education Building, new furnaces in the Education Building and an expensive repair to the elevator), more major projects are ahead.

The Village of Skokie recently examined the property and have advised that we have to sealcoat and restripe all the parking areas. A recent bid was \$3,400.

Air-conditioning was not included when the new furnaces were installed in the Education Building this winter. Air-conditioners need to be installed on the east side of the Education Building to provide air-conditioning to the offices in the building. The estimate is \$4,000.

A recent water leak in the parsonage has revealed structural problems that need to be addressed.

There will be a Summer Celebration held for the girls. One of the fundraisers at this event will be a Wine Pull - various bottles of wine are in bags so people can't see the bottle of wine they will get. Each "pull" is \$20. The wine bags are created with beautiful and colorful African fabrics. A group of Central volunteers is going to prepare and sew the wine bags on **Thursday, June 27** from **9:30 am to noon** in Fellowship Hall.
